Company 'Profiles':**Introduction To Company Sponsors Of 50 Years Ago****Rockwell Manufacturing Company**

Rockwell Manufacturing started its journey in the year 1919, when the company President and treasurer, Willard Rockwell, bought a small axle plant named Wisconsin Parts Company. The small axle plant carried on the manufacturing process of a new and improved bearing system for truck axles, based on the unique designs created by Rockwell, himself.

In the decade of the 1950s, Willard Rockwell took a vital decision, the basis of which a company merger took place between Wisconsin Parts, Standard Steel, and the Spring and Timken Detroit Company. This led to the successful beginning of the Rockwell Spring and Axle Company.

Rockwell Manufacturing merged with several other companies, and, in 1973, became Rockwell International, run by Willard Rockwell, Jr.

Company 'Profiles': Introduction To Company Sponsors Of 50 Years Ago

Akron Paint & Varnish, Inc.

Akron Paint & Varnish, Inc. was founded in 1878 by J. Martin Beck and Edward G. Kubler under the name of Akron Varnish Works. The product line consisted of wood varnishes and black enamels. In 1893, the safety bicycle was invented; more than half the nation's bikes were finished with enamel from Akron Varnish Works.

In 1912, the factory was expanded to accommodate the fast-growing automobile industry. With black being the acceptable color for automobiles, Akron Varnish Works enjoyed outstanding prosperity. The company continued to grow and develop new products, which enabled them to survive The Great Depression. In 1935, the stockholders changed the firm's name to The Akron Paint & Varnish Company, to accommodate a new line of paints and varnishes. The trade sales part of the business grew, with the company continuing to sell to the tire industry, the airline industry, and for government applications.

The present name of Akron Paint & Varnish, Inc. is APV Engineered Coatings.

Warner & Swasey Company

The Warner & Swasey Company was an American manufacturer of high-quality special machinery and machine tools. Founded in 1880 by Worcester Reed Warner (1846-1929) and Ambrose Swasey (1846-1937), the company was best known for two general types of products: astronomical telescopes (and other equipment for astronomical observatories) and lathes. The development of large optical telescopes in the 19th and 20th centuries relied upon

the advancement of machine tool technology, as provided by Warner & Swasey.

The first Warner & Swasey telescope was sold to Beloit College for its new Smith Observatory, and had a 9.5-inch lens made by Alvan Clark & Sons. Among the notable instruments the company built were the telescopes for Lick Observatory (1883), the United States Naval Observatory (1893), Yerkes Observatory (1897), and Canada's Dominion Astrophysical Observatory (1916). In 1919, the company's founders donated their private observatory in East Cleveland, Ohio, to Case Western Reserve University. Today's Warner and Swasey Observatory grew from that facility. The company was acquired by Bendix Corporation in 1980.
